Kiwanis supports Morristown, Nadaburg schools

The Kiwanis Club of Sun City West, through its foundation, has been busy providing for some of the special needs of the Morristown and Nadaburg unified school districts.

Besides providing disinfectants and wipes, thermometers, masks and desk dividers, the club has also donated a pallet of bottled water (1,920 bottles) and 20 cartons of healthy snacks to the districts. The club also stepped up to support Morristown's weekend food program after a long-term sponsor ended its sponsorship.

The Sun City West Kiwanis Club Foundation underwrote the entire cost of Morristown's weekend food program for the 2021-22 school year, an expense of \$3,663. Undertaking this sponsorship enabled Morristown Elementary School to continue providing food bags to its students, thereby ensuring they have healthy food to eat over the weekend.

The Nadaburg Unified School District and Morristown Elementary School District, which includes Desert Oasis, Nadaburg and Morristown el-

ementary schools, publicly thanked the Kiwanis Club of Sun City West for their on-going financial support. In attendance at the Nadaburg District Board's Sept. 8 meeting were Dr. Aspasia Angelou, District Superintendent, members of the Nadaburg School Board and six Sun City West Kiwanians.
